#### **Handgun Prohibition Notice for Meetings of Governmental Entities**

- 4. deliberating the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee; or to hear a complaint or charge against an officer or employee unless the officer or employee who is the subject of the deliberation or hearing requests a public hearing. [Tex. Govt. Code §551.074]
- 5. deliberating the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel or devices. [Tex. Govt. Code §551.076]
- 6. discussing or deliberating commercial or financial information that the city has received from a business prospect that the city seeks to have locate, stay or expand in or near the city and with which the city is conducting economic development negotiations; or deliberating the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect. [Tex Govt. Code §551.087]
- deliberating security assessments or deployments relating to information resources technology, network security information, or the deployment or specific occasions for implementations of security personnel, critical infrastructure, or security devices. [Tex Govt. Code §551.089]

TO Honorable Members of the Judicial Nominating Commission

**Consider Judicial Nominating Committee Recommendation for Municipal Judges of a 3% Increase** 

As you may be aware, in Section 13-5.2(a)(3) of the Dallas City Code provides that the Judicial Nominating Commissions (JNC) shall review and make a recommendation to the City Council Ad Hoc Nominations Committee on the salary structure for Municipal Judges.

City staff evaluated a 3% increase for the Administrative Judge, Municipal Judges, and Associate Judges. The following analysis and recommendation based on market data would be:

- Associate Judges are going from \$66.10 to \$68.08 (3%)
- Municipal Judges are going from \$140,000 to \$144,200 (3%)
- Administrative Judge is going from \$155,00 to \$159,650 (3%)

During this meeting, the JNC will discuss the 3% increase and appointment process of the municipal judge based on previous practice in preparation for the Municipal judge term that end on May 31, 2024.
