CHAPTER XXIV. SEC. 13. APPOINTMENT AND TENURE OF COMMISSIONS AND BOARDS.		
Council appointees to boards, commissions, and equivalent bodies governed by the charter must reside in the council district of the council district they serve. If such an appointee if unavailable, a council member may appoint a city resident outside of their district pending a vote of approval of two-thirds of the full city council. This vote must be separate than council approval of appointments of individuals who reside in the district they serve. Such appointments of individuals outside of the district will have a term of service of no more than 12 months, but are eligible for reappointment by the same full council approval process. The mayor can appoint anyone as long as they live in the city.
