WHEREAS, on February 25, 2015, City Council authorized a five-year master agreement for the purchase of various software including perpetual, fixed term, subscription and software as a service, software maintenance support and implementation services with SHI Government Solutions, Inc. in the amount of \$4,800,155.00, Mobile Wireless, LLC in the amount of \$231,250.00 and Carahsoft Technology Corporation in the amount of \$160,000.00, through the Department of Information Resources, State of Texas Cooperative contract, in a total amount not to exceed \$5,191,405.00, by Resolution No. 15-0340; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2018, Administrative Action No. 18-6579 authorized a service contract for continuous use of software licenses, maintenance, and support services for FastTrack software with SHI Government Solutions, Inc. through the State of Texas Department of Information Resources contract DR-TSO-3984, in an amount not to exceed \$69,993.80.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with SHI Government Solutions, Inc. (502145) through the Texas Association of School Boards cooperative agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for maintenance and support of the existing transportation for hire tracking software system for the Department of Aviation for a term of two years, in an amount not to exceed \$79,986.00. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payment to SHI Government Solutions, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by SHI Government Solutions, Inc. under the contract.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$79,986.00 (subject to annual appropriations) to SHI Government Solutions, Inc. from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract No. DSV-2020-00013040.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
