WHEREAS, on January 25, 2012, City Council authorized a three-year service contract for the removal and disposal of water and debris from storage tanks and containment vaults with Agricultural Services Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$277,248.60, by Resolution No. 12-0267; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2015, Administrative Action No. 15-5735 authorized to extend the service contract with Agricultural Services Inc. for the removal and disposal of water and debris from storage tanks and containment vaults from January 25, 2015 to January 24, 2016, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2016, Administrative Action No. 16-5623 authorized to extend the service contract with Agricultural Services Inc. for the removal and disposal of water and debris from storage tanks and containment vaults from January 25, 2016 to January 24, 2017, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, on December 22, 2016, Administrative Action No. 17-5522 authorized to extend the service contract with Agricultural Services Inc. for the removal and disposal of water and debris from storage tanks and containment vaults from January 24, 2017 to January 24, 2019, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2019, Administrative Action No. 19-5731 authorized to extend the service contract with Agricultural Services Inc. for the removal and disposal of water and debris from storage tanks and containment vaults from January 24, 2019 to January 24, 2020, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2019, Administrative Action No. 20-0873 authorized to extend the service contract with Agricultural Services Inc. for the removal and disposal of water and debris from storage tanks and containment vaults from June 24, 2019 to September 30, 2020, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020, Administrative Action No. 20-5546 authorized to increase the service contract with Agricultural Services, Inc. dba ASI Environmental Services for the removal and disposal of water and debris from storage tanks and containment vaults, in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00, from \$277,248.60 to \$327,248.60.

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Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Agricultural Services, Inc. dba ASI Environmental Services (VS0000032498), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for labor, equipment, transportation and supervision for the removal of excess contaminated or non-contaminated water and contaminated fuel from above and underground storage tanks and associated containment vaults for a term of five years, in the estimated amount of \$558,303.40. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Agricultural Services, Inc. dba ASI Environmental Services shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Agricultural Services, Inc. dba ASI Environmental Services under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$558,303.40, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Agricultural Services, Inc. dba ASI Environmental Services from Service Price Agreement Contract No. POM-2020-00013169.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
