WHEREAS, the City of Dallas and Dallas County entered into a Master Agreement Governing Transportation Capital Improvement Projects, hereinafter (“Master Agreement”) on August 2, 2011 by Commissioners Court Order 2011-1287 for the purpose of transportation improvements on roads inside Dallas County; and

WHEREAS, Dallas County requested it be designated as the Lead Agency for the Project and will provide the Project Manager; and

WHEREAS, Dallas County entered into an Advance Funding Agreement, hereinafter (“AFA”) with the State of Texas by and through the Texas Department of Transportation, hereinafter (“TxDOT”) on November 19, 2019 by Commissioners Court Order 2019-1290 for TxDOT to provide funding in the amount of \$225,000.00 for the study and preliminary engineering of the Central Trail Project; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 791 of The Texas Government Code and Chapters 251 and 472 of the Texas Transportation Code provide authorization for local governments to contract with each other for the performance of governmental functions and services, as well as joint funding of road construction or improvements of road or street projects.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the President of the Park and Recreation Board and the City Manager are hereby authorized to execute a Capital Improvement Program Funding Agreement with Dallas County, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the study and preliminary engineering of the Central Trail, a 1.9 mile multi-use bike/pedestrian facility located from the southern end of the Central Trail at Buckingham Road in the city of Richardson, to the Cottonwood Creek Trail near the Dallas Area Rapid Transit Forest Lane Station in the city of Dallas and execution of the funding agreement including all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement.

SECTION 2. That this contract is designated as Contract No. PKR-2020-00013987.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
