~~**WHEREAS**, the City has established Tax Increment Financing Reinvestment Zone Number Twenty One (“University TIF District” or “District”) pursuant to Ordinance No. 30733, authorized by the City Council on December 13, 2017, as authorized by the Tax Increment Financing Act, Chapter 311 of the Texas Tax Code, as amended; and~~

~~**WHEREAS**, the University TIF District was created to establish a funding mechanism to stimulate private investment and development in Dallas’ southern sector and provide public amenities including trail connections in northern Dallas while taking advantage of each area’s strategic regional location adjacent to major universities and transportation corridors; and~~

~~**WHEREAS**, on September 10, 2020, the University TIF District Board of Directors adopted the By-Laws for the University TIF District and forwarded a recommendation of approval to the City Council.~~
