WHEREAS, on August 26, 2015, City Council authorized an acquisition contract for the purchase and implementation of an aircraft identification and billing solution for Aviation in the amount of \$137,581.00; and a three-year service contract, with two one-year renewal options, for maintenance and support for an aircraft identification and billing solution in the amount of \$173,573.85 with Vector Airport Systems, LLC, in a total amount not to exceed \$311,154.85, by Resolution No. 15-1522.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute **(1)** the ratification for payments to Vector Airport Systems, LLC for aircraft fee collection and billing services rendered from August 25, 2020 to March 2021 in the estimated amount of \$392,394.99; and **(2)** a service contract with Vector Airport Systems, LLC (VS85745), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for aircraft fee collection and billing services for the Department of Aviation for a term of five years for an estimated annual gross revenue of \$5,097,027.38.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to receive and deposit funds received from Vector Airport Systems, LLC in Aviation Fund, Fund 0130, Department AVI, Unit 7962, Revenue Code 7706; Aviation Fund, Fund 0130, Department AVI, Unit 7722, Revenue Code 7705; and Aviation Fund, Fund 0130, Department AVI, Unit 7722, Revenue Code 7701.

SECTION 3. That the City will pay Vector Airport Systems, LLC 13% of all revenues collected according to the terms of the contract. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse 13% commission and the ratification amount from Aviation Fund, Fund 0130, Department AVI, Unit 7722, and Object Code 3072 to Vector Airport Systems, according to the terms of the contract.

SECTION 4. That this contract is designated as Contract No. AVI-2021-00015021.

SECTION 5. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
