WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) has been designated as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Area by the Governor of Texas in accordance with federal law; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Council (RTC), comprised primarily of local elected officials, is the regional transportation policy body associated with NCTCOG and has been and continues to be a forum for cooperative decisions on transportation; and

WHEREAS, the RTC is committed to the development and implementation of policies, projects, and programs to improve air quality and reduce emissions; and

WHEREAS, NCTCOG published the "Call for Projects" on September 15, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas submitted the list of corridor signals that met the "Call for Project" criteria; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2018, the RTC approved funding for implementation of the Minor Intersection Improvement Program in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Area for the purpose of low-cost operational improvements at signalized intersections; and

WHEREAS, the NCTCOG selected corridor(s) in the City of Dallas as a part of the Minor Intersection Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas was awarded Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program funds that will go directly to NCTCOG for administering the reimbursement of minor intersection improvement program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas shall provide 11.4 percent local match required for the off-system locations in the amount of \$102,600.00; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code provides authority for the NCTCOG and the City of Dallas to enter into this agreement for the provision of governmental functions and services of mutual interest.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement between the City of Dallas and North Central Texas Council of Government, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to pay 11.4 percent local match of the off-system detection system upgrades for the purpose of implementation of the Minor Intersection Improvement Program, in an amount not to exceed \$102,600.00.

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SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$102,600.00 to North Central Texas Council of Governments in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement from General Fund, Fund 0001, Department TRN, Unit 3049, Activity PB24, Object 4820, Program TRN3049COG, Encumbrance/Contract No. TRN-2019-00010822, Vendor 066264.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
