WHEREAS, on April 15, 2020, City Council authorized the preliminary adoption of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act Relief Funds by Resolution No. 20-0599; and

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2020, City Council authorized the City Manager to execute any and all grant agreements necessary to receive COVID-19 funding from federal and state sources by Resolution No. 20-0644; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas through the Office of Community Care, seek to provide financial support to City of Dallas area childcare providers who have been adversely affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. This support is in an effort to support childcare providers who have lost substantial revenue and seen increased expenses as a result of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Workforce Solutions Greater Dallas, a quasi-governmental and non-profit organization, will work with ChildCareGroup to administer this program. This will allow the program to utilize an entity that already has extensive experience in this field.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement with Dallas County Local Workforce Development Board dba Workforce Solutions Greater Dallas, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to administer the Childcare Providers Micro-Grant Program for the period of August 1, 2020 through December 30, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$680,000.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$680,000.00 to Dallas County Local Workforce Development Board dba Workforce Solutions Greater Dallas from the Coronavirus Relief Fund, Fund F620, Department MGT, Unit 955F, Object 3070, Encumbrance/Contract No. OCC-2020-00014130, Vendor VC0000006342.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
