WHEREAS, the City of Dallas desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF); and

WHEREAS, the intent of this joint effort along with the (DOJ), Bureau of (ATF) to establish and define a partnership between the parties that will result in an ATF National Integrated Ballistic Information Network system installation, operation, and administration for the collection, timely analysis, and dissemination of crime gun data to enhance the efforts of law enforcement to integrate resources to reduce firearms violence, identify shooters, and refer them for prosecution and; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to enter this Memorandum of Understanding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, upon approval as to form by the City Attorney, a Memorandum of Understanding with the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) National Integrated Ballistic Information Network system installation, operation, and administration, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for collection, timely analysis, and dissemination of crime gun data to enhance the efforts of law enforcement to integrate resources to reduce firearms violence, identify shooters, and refer them for prosecution.

SECTION 2. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DPD-2020-00014003.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
