WHEREAS, on February 25, 2015, City Council authorized a five-year service contract for Geographic Information System software maintenance with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$1,523,589.70, by Resolution No. 15-0338; and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2018, City Council authorized a three-year acquisition contract for the purchase of enterprise software licenses and maintenance for Geographic Information System software with ESRI, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$1,770,300.00, by Resolution No. 18-0286; and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2018, Administrative Action No. 18-5572 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to amend the contract terms to begin on March 1, 2018 and end three years thereafter, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2018, Administrative Action No. 18-6206 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to amend Appendix B (EA Fee Schedule), with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with ESRI, Inc. dba Esri (265847), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the purchase of enterprise software licenses and maintenance for Geographic Information System software for the Department of Information and Technology Services for a term of three years, in an amount not to exceed \$2,325,000.00. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments to ESRI, Inc. dba Esri shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by ESRI, Inc. dba Esri under the contract.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,325,000.00 (subject to annual appropriations) to ESRI, Inc. dba Esri from Service Contract No. DSV-2021-00015500.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
