Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction services contract with HQS Construction, LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the construction of Streetscape/Urban Design Street Group 17-7006, in an amount not to exceed \$2,642,465.00, this being the lowest responsible bid received as indicated by the tabulation of bids.

SECTION 2. That in order to reimburse and finance the authorized disbursements described herein, the City intends to issue one or more commercial paper notes as part of its General Obligation Commercial Paper Notes Series A, and Series B, and use the proceeds thereof to reimburse the disbursements described herein.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,642,465.00 to HQS Construction, LLC in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract, as follows:
