WHEREAS, on December 11, 2019, the City Council authorized an engineering services contract with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. to provide design and construction administration services for the Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements Project at Dallas Love Field, in an amount not to exceed \$2,377,100.00 by Resolution No. 19-1855; and

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2021, the City Council authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the engineering services contract with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. to provide additional design and construction administration services for the Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements Project at Dallas Love Field, in an amount not to exceed \$450,826.00, by Resolution No. 21-1943; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize a construction services contract for the Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements Project at Dallas Love Field with RoeschCo Construction, LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$30,000,607.49.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction services contract with RoeschCo Construction, LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide construction services for the Lemmon Avenue Streetscape Enhancements Project at Dallas Love Field, in an amount not to exceed \$30,000,607.49.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$30,000,607.49 in the Aviation Construction Fund, Fund 0131, Department AVI, Unit W387, Object 4599.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$30,000,607.49 to RoeschCo Construction, LLC in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract from the Aviation Construction Fund, Fund 0131, Department AVI, Unit W387, Object 4599, Activity AAIP, Program AVIW387, Commodity 91200, Encumbrance/Contract No. CX-AVI-2023-00021311, Vendor VC24588.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
