WHEREAS, on December 12, 2018, the City Council authorized a three-year service price agreement for inspection and maintenance for fire extinguishers and sprinkler systems with American Fire Protection Group Inc in the amount of \$5,051,309.56 and Safety Control LLC in the amount of \$1,826,503.41, by Resolution No. 18-1800.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Safety Control LLC (VS98301) in the estimated amount of \$1,999,019.68 and Total Fire & Safety, Inc. (117409) in the estimated amount of \$6,440,520.34, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for citywide fire extinguisher and sprinkler system maintenance and repairs for a term of three years in a total estimated amount of \$8,439,540.02. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Safety Control LLC and Total Fire & Safety, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Safety Control LLC and Total Fire & Safety, Inc. under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$8,439,540.02 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Safety Control LLC and Total Fire & Safety, Inc. from Service Price Agreement Contract No. BSD-2023-00021596.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
