WHEREAS, on November 10, 2015, the City Council authorized a three-year service contract with Good Earth Corporation for median maintenance and mowing of Texas Department of Transportation rights-of-way within the corporate boundaries of Dallas, in the amount of \$9,464,660.00, by Resolution No. 15-2050; and

WHEREAS, on November 11, 2018, Administrative Action No. 18-6866 authorized to extend the service contract for one year for median maintenance and mowing of Texas Department of Transportation right-of-way within the corporate boundaries of Dallas with Good Earth Corporation from January 30, 2019 to January 29, 2020, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount; and

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2019, the City Council authorized execute a service price agreement with Good Earth Corporation for grounds maintenance services of Texas Department of Transportation properties within the corporate boundaries of the city of Dallas for the Department of Public Works for a term of three years by Resolution No. 19-1805; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to extend the service price agreement with Good Earth Corporation for one year for grounds maintenance services of Texas Department of Transportation properties within the corporate boundaries of the city of Dallas for the Department of Public Works from June 13, 2023 to June 13, 2024, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an extension to the service price agreement with Good Earth Corporation for grounds maintenance services of Texas Department of Transportation properties within the corporate boundaries of the city of Dallas for the Department of Public Works from June 13, 2023 through June 13, 2024 with no cost consideration to the City.

SECTION 2. That this contract is designated as Contract No. PBW-2019-00010547.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
