**WHEREAS,** on May 23, 2018, the City Council authorized a three-year service contract, with two one-year renewal options, to provide school crossing guard services with All City Management Services, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$15,513,600, by Resolution No. 18-0773; and

**WHEREAS,** on June 9, 2021, the City Council authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to exercise the first of two, one-year renewal options, to the service contract with All City Management Services, Inc. for school crossing guard services for Court and Detention Services, in an amount not to exceed \$4,521,145, by Resolution No. 21-1015; and

**WHEREAS,** on August 24, 2022, the City Council authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to exercise the second of two, one-year renewal options, to the service contract with All City Management Services, Inc. for school crossing guard services for Court & Detention Services, in an amount not to exceed \$5,402,700, by Resolution No. 22-1223.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with All City Management Services, Inc. (VS97685), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for school crossing guard services for Court & Detention Services for a term of three years, in an amount not to exceed \$23,928,072. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed basis, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments made to All City Management Services, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by All City Management Services, Inc. under the contract.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$23,928,072 (subject to annual appropriations) to All City Management Services, Inc. from Service Contract No. CTS-2023-00021717.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
