WHEREAS, on October 8, 2019, the City Council authorized a three-year service price agreement for pressure washing, scraping, and sweeping of flat surfaces, pressure washing of vertical surfaces, and pressure washing of vehicles with H and W Cleaning Systems, Inc. in an estimated amount of \$1,649,916.12 and FW Fleet Clean, LLC, in an estimated amount of \$16,296.00, in a total estimated amount of \$1,666,212.12, by Resolution No. 19-1591.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Texas Power Wash dba Texas Power Wash Pros, LLC (VC25995), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for Citywide pressure washing, scraping, and sweeping of flat surfaces, pressure washing of vertical surfaces, and pressure washing of vehicles for a term of five years, in the estimated amount of \$1,387,559.58. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Texas Power Wash dba Texas Power Wash Pros, LLC shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Texas Power Wash dba Texas Power Wash Pros, LLC under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$1,387,559.58 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Texas Power Wash dba Texas Power Wash Pros, LLC from Service Price Agreement Contract No. POM-2022-00019751.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
