WHEREAS, a lawsuit styled Selina Workman and Alice Jackson v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-19-01610, was filed by the plaintiff, Selina Workman, seeking compensation from the City of Dallas for alleged bodily injuries and other damages sustained in an automobile collision on May 15, 2017, involving a Dallas Police Department vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the plaintiff has agreed to a proposed settlement of her claim whereby the City will pay Selina Workman, Bailey and Galyen, Attorneys at Law, and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$32,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to settle this lawsuit.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposed settlement of Selina Workman's claim in the lawsuit styled Selina Workman and Alice Jackson v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-19-01610, in an amount not to exceed \$32,000.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to pay Selina Workman, Bailey and Galyen, Attorneys at Law, and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$32,000.00 from Liability Reserve Fund, Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Object 3521, Vendor MVORM001.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
