WHEREAS, on December 11, 2019, the City Council authorized a professional services contract with HDR Engineering Inc., to provide engineering services for the City of Dallas Water Production Facilities Strategic Plan, in an amount not to exceed \$4,595,000.00, by Resolution No. 19-1932; and

WHEREAS, additional services are required to perform a Risk and Resiliency Assessment of the Dallas Water Utilities' water system and prepare an updated Emergency Response Plan in compliance with the America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018; and

WHEREAS, additional services are also required to further evaluate and develop alternative solutions to address performance limiting factors at each of Dallas Water Utilities' water treatment plants; and

WHEREAS, HDR Engineering, Inc., 17111 Preston Road, Texas 75248 has submitted an acceptable proposal to provide these engineering services; and

WHEREAS, Dallas Water Utilities recommends that Contract No. 19-119E be increased by \$752,843.00, from \$4,595,000.00 to \$5,347,843.00.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposed Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the professional services contract be accepted and that Contract No. 19-119E with HDR Engineering, Inc. be revised accordingly.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the professional services with HDR Engineering, Inc., approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide additional engineering services required to perform a Risk and Resiliency Assessment of the Dallas Water Utilities' water system and prepare an updated Emergency Response Plan in compliance with the America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018, in an amount not to exceed \$752,843.00, increasing the contract amount from \$4,595,000.00 to \$5,347,843.00.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$752,843.00 to HDR Engineering, Inc. from the Water Construction Fund, Fund 0102, Department DWU, Unit CW01, Object 4111, Program 719119, Encumbrance/Contract No. DWU-2019-00011112, Vendor 181219.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
