## SUBJECT Introduction of "Serve Robotics" Delivery Robots

Last week the City was notified that Serve Robotics, a personal delivery device company, would initiate a soft launch of its operations in Dallas, through a partnership with Uber Eats, on March 17, 2025. The company's initial rollout is focused in Uptown with potential future expansion to other parts of the City. Serve Robotics currently operates in Miami, Los Angeles, Glendale, West Hollywood, and Long Beach.

As communicated in a November 2024 <u>memorandum to City Council</u>, a partnership between Uber Eats and Avride, launched a personal delivery device in Dallas. Section 552A of the Texas Transportation Code regulates these devices and can be found <u>here</u>.
