WHEREAS, on March 1, 2024, the City of Dallas released Request for Qualifications "CIZ24-TRN-3071-Traffic Signal Design Professional Engineering Services - Multiple Contracts" for professional engineering services for the development of traffic signal plans, specifications, and estimates for 12 traffic signal groups and received 15 proposals from interested firms; and

WHEREAS, in May 2024, a five-member selection committee consisting of staff from the Department of Transportation, Department of Public Works, and Business Enterprise Hub reviewed and evaluated the proposals; and

WHEREAS, the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) asked firms to rank their preference for each of the 12 traffic signal groups, and based on the RFQ responses, the five-member selection committee ranked the firms and subsequently reviewed, evaluated the firms, and ranked them for each specific signal package, taking into consideration each firm's stated preferred traffic signal group; and

WHEREAS, the 12 traffic signal groups were assigned to the most highly qualified proposer for that signal group and based on the firm's ranking, Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., was selected by the review committee as the most highly qualified proposer to provide professional services specifically for the four traffic signal intersections in Group 3 as shown in the firm ranking list below:

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a professional engineering services contract with Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., the most highly qualified proposer specifically for traffic signal design services, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the four intersections in Group 3 as follows: Hampton Road at Colorado Boulevard; Hampton Road at Wright Street; Hampton Road at Perryton Drive; Hampton Road at Red Bird Lane; and other related tasks, in an amount not to exceed \$431,400.00.

SECTION 2. That in order to reimburse and finance the authorized disbursements described herein from General Obligation bonds, the City intends to issue one or more commercial paper notes as part of its General Obligation Commercial Paper Notes Series 2017A, and Series 2017B, and use the proceeds thereof to reimburse the disbursements described herein.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$431,400.00 to Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., from the Street and Transportation (A) Fund, Fund 1V22, Department PBW, Unit VA40, Object 4820, Activity TR01, Program TP17VA40, Encumbrance/Contract No. TRN-2025-00026262, Vendor VS0000016149.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
