WHEREAS, on January 27, 2021, the City Council authorized the acceptance of rental assistance program funds and a new Emergency Rental Assistance Program to provide up to twelve months rental and utility assistance to low-income households impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic by Resolution No. 21-0240.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with Carahsoft Technology Corporation (VS0000009713) through the Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for application and hosting services and ongoing technical and maintenance support for the GovTechCloud and KinetechCloud Program and Claims Management System for the Office of Community Care and Empowerment, for a term of three years, in an amount not to exceed \$202,741.77 ~~343,263.06~~. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payment to Carahsoft Technology Corporation shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Carahsoft Technology Corporation under the cooperative purchasing agreement.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$202,741.77 ~~343,263.06~~ (subject to annual appropriations) to Carahsoft Technology Corporation from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract No. DSV-2025-00027185.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
