WHEREAS, a lawsuit styled Marcus Ventresca v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-19-09505 was filed by the plaintiff, Marcus Ventresca, seeking compensation from the City of Dallas for alleged bodily injuries and other damages sustained in an automobile collision on July 12, 2017, involving a Park and Recreation employee who was operating a city-owned vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the plaintiff has agreed to a proposed settlement of his claim whereby the City will pay Marcus Ventresca, the Law Offices of Tim O'Hare, and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$100,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to settle this lawsuit.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposed settlement of the lawsuit styled Marcus Ventresca v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-19-09505, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to pay Marcus Ventresca, the Law Offices of Tim O'Hare, and all other persons having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$100,000.00 from Liability Reserve Fund, Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Object 3521, Vendor MVORM001.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
