WHEREAS, on April 28, 2021, the City Council authorized a three-year service price agreement for court reporting services for various City departments with Magna Legal Services, in the estimated amount of \$288,508.24, by Resolution No. 21-0707.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a three-year cooperative purchasing service price agreement with MLS Parent Holdings LLC dba Magna Legal Services LLC (VC29581) through the interlocal cooperative agreement with Dallas Area Rapid Transit, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for court reporting services for the City Attorney's Office, in an estimated amount of \$325,000.00. The amount payable pursuant to this cooperative purchasing service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this cooperative purchasing service price agreement during its term. Payments made to MLS Parent Holdings LLC dba Magna Legal Services LLC shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by MLS Parent Holdings LLC dba Magna Legal Services LLC under the cooperative purchasing service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of \$325,000.00 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this cooperative purchasing service price agreement during its term to with MLS Parent Holdings LLC dba Magna Legal Services LLC from Cooperative Purchase Service Price Agreement Contract No. ATT-2025-00028889.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
