WHEREAS, a lawsuit, styled Sterling Bradshaw v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-23-10784, was filed by the plaintiff Sterling Bradshaw, seeking compensation from the City of Dallas for alleged bodily injuries and other damages sustained in an automobile accident on March 24, 2022, involving an Office of Environmental Quality & Sustainability employee operating a city-owned vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the plaintiff, Sterling Bradshaw, has agreed to a proposed settlement of his claims whereby the City will pay Sterling Bradshaw, The Peters Firm, PLLC, and all other persons and entities having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$30,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to settle this lawsuit.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposed settlement of the claims filed by Sterling Bradshaw in the lawsuit styled, Sterling Bradshaw v. City of Dallas, Cause No. DC-23-10784, in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to pay Sterling Bradshaw, The Peters Firm, PLLC, and all other persons and entities having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the amount of \$30,000.00 from the Liability Reserve Fund, Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Object 3521, Vendor MVORM001.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
