WHEREAS, the City of Dallas is committed to supporting the Comprehensive Environmental & Climate Action Plan, adopted in May 2020 to reduce greenhouse gas emissions citywide, and this project aligns with that initiative; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2024, the City Council authorized the transfer and reallocation of ARPA funds from the U.S. Department of Treasury for the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to the ARPA Redevelopment multi-year fund to provide assistance with completing projects by Resolution No. 24-0315; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 232.6 kW-DC solar photovoltaic system is projected to reduce the facility's annual energy usage by approximately 72% compared to 2024 usage and decrease annual energy costs by an estimated \$23,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Beckley Saner Recreation Center, located at 114 West Hobson Avenue, requires the installation of a solar photovoltaic system to support the City's renewable energy and sustainability goals; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals was issued in accordance with Chapter 252 of the Texas Local Government Code; and METCO Engineering, Inc., was selected as the most advantageous; and

WHEREAS, it is now desirable to authorize a construction contract for the installation of a solar photovoltaic system at 114 West Hobson Avenue with METCO Engineering, Inc.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with METCO Engineering, Inc., most advantageous proposer of five, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the installation of a solar photovoltaic system at Beckley-Saner Recreation Center located at 114 West Hobson Avenue, in an amount not to exceed \$488,418.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$488,418.00 to METCO Engineering, Inc. from the ARPA Redevelopment Fund, Fund 0A72, Department MGT, Unit AR17, Object Code 4310, Activity CCSS, Program BS19264. and Encumbrance/Contract No. **BSD-2026-00029143** [FRM-2026-00029143](#), Vendor VS0000025965.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
