WHEREAS, the City of Dallas completed a Rehabilitation Alternative Analysis for multiple dams owned and operated by Dallas Water Utilities (DWU) to determine the hydraulic capacity and preliminary rehabilitation alternatives; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that Lake Cliff Dam is hydraulically inadequate and should be modified to comply with Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) criteria; and

WHEREAS, preliminary engineering services are required to develop a design report to determine the preferred design alternative to modify Lake Cliff Dam to be compliant with TCEQ dam safety regulations; and

WHEREAS, Arredondo, Zepeda & Brunz, LLC, 11355 McCree Road, Dallas, Texas 75238 has submitted an acceptable proposal to provide these engineering services.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposal submitted by Arredondo, Zepeda & Brunz, LLC, Contract No. 24-373E, in the amount of \$243,634.46 be approved and the consultant be authorized to perform the required engineering services.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a professional services contract with Arredondo, Zepeda & Brunz, LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to provide preliminary engineering services required for dam spillway rehabilitation improvements at Lake Cliff Dam, in an amount not to exceed \$243,634.46.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$243,634.46 to Arredondo, Zepeda & Brunz, LLC, from the Storm Drainage Management Capital Construction Fund, Fund 0063, Department SDM, Unit W860, Activity SD01, Object 3070, Program SD24W860, Encumbrance/Contract No. SDM-2025-00026693, Vendor 080851.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
