WHEREAS, on June 14, 2017, the City Council authorized a professional services contract with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for traffic signal design services of 75 traffic signals at various intersections, which included this project, by Resolution No. 17-0931; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2025, the City of Dallas Office of Procurement Services publicly advertised for competitive bids for CIZ25-TRN-3168 – 2024 Bond Traffic Signal Construction – Group 1 to construct two new traffic signals at the intersections of Chrysalis Drive at Wheatland Road and Red Bird Lane at Pastor Bailey Drive; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2025, the City of Dallas Office of Procurement Services received five bids for the project, listed as follows:

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction services contract with Texas Standard Construction, Ltd., lowest responsible bidder of five, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the 2024 Bond Traffic Signal Construction – Group 1 Project to construct two new traffic signals at the intersections of Chrysalis Drive at Wheatland Road and Red Bird Lane at Pastor Bailey Drive, in an amount not to exceed \$824,788.36.

SECTION 2. That expenditures made pursuant to this Resolution shall be made from lawfully available funds, including the General Obligation Commercial Paper Notes Series A and B (the “Commercial Paper Notes”), as amended, and any expenditures made pursuant to this Resolution from lawfully available funds shall be reimbursed from the proceeds of the Commercial Paper Notes or from the proceeds of general obligation bonds issued by the City up to the amount of expenditures authorized by this Resolution.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$824,788.36 to Texas Standard Construction, Ltd., in accordance with the terms and conditions of the agreement, as follows:
