WHEREAS, a lawsuit, styled Armonte Brim and Kristian McCullough v. City of Dallas and Tory Tinsley, Cause No. DC-23-19903, was filed by the plaintiff Armonte Brim and Kristian McCullough, seeking compensation from the City of Dallas for alleged bodily injuries and other damages sustained in an automobile collision on July 27, 2023, involving a Department of Sanitation Services employee operating a city-owned vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the plaintiff, Kristian McCullough, has agreed to a proposed settlement of her claims whereby the City will pay Kristian McCullough, Fleming, Nolen, & Jez, LLP, and all other persons and entities having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$55,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it is in the City's best interest to settle this lawsuit.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the proposed settlement of the claims filed by Kristian McCullough in the lawsuit styled, Armonte Brim and Kristian McCullough v. City of Dallas and Tory Tinsley, Cause No. DC-23-19903, in an amount not to exceed \$55,000.00 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to pay Kristian McCullough, Fleming, Nolen, & Jez, LLP, and all other persons and entities having an interest in the settlement proceeds, the total amount of \$55,000.00 from Liability Reserve Fund, Fund 0192, Department ORM, Unit 3890, Object 3521, Vendor MVORM001.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
