WHEREAS, on June 23, 2021, the City Council authorized the acceptance of grant funds from the United States Department of Treasury for the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to provide relief during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic by Resolution No. 21-1149, and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2021, the City Council authorized the final reading and adoption of the appropriation ordinance for the FY 2021-22 City of Dallas Operating, Capital, and Grant & Trust Budgets, which included the American Rescue Plan Act funds from the United States Department of Treasury for the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds by Resolution No. 21-1590, and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2024, the City Council authorized the transfer and reallocation of ARPA funds from the U.S. Department of Treasury for the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund to the ARPA Redevelopment multi-year fund to provide assistance with completing projects by Resolution No. 24-0315, and

WHEREAS, this action will authorize Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the professional services contract with Hahnfeld Associates, Architects and Planners, Inc. AEC Holdco, LLC dba Grace Hebert Curtis Architects, LLC to provide schematic design, design development, construction documents, bidding and construction administration for a multipurpose center and park located at 9759 Forest Lane, in an amount not to exceed \$714,075.00, increasing the original contract amount from \$99,875.00 to \$813,950.00.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the President of the Park and Recreation Board and City Manager are hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the professional services contract with Hahnfeld Associates, Architects and Planners, Inc. AEC Holdco, LLC dba Grace Hebert Curtis Architects, LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for engineering design services that include providing a schematic design, design development, construction documents, bidding and construction administration for a multipurpose center and park located at 9759 Forest Lane, in an amount not to exceed \$714,075.00, increasing the original contract amount from \$99,875.00 to \$813,950.00.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$714,075.00, to Hahnfeld Associates, Architects and Planners, Inc. AEC Holdco, LLC dba Grace Hebert Curtis Architects, LLC, Inc., as follows:
