WHEREAS, on August 24, 2022, the City Council authorized the acceptance of grant funds from the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) for the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (CFDA / Assistance Listing No. 21 .027, Federal Award Identification No. 2021-CS-21027, TPWD Contract No. CA-0003308, Project No. AR-000001) in the amount of \$20,000,000.00 for the purpose of housing and workforce development, parks and trails, libraries and cultural centers, and citizens health and physical development by Resolution 22-1240; and

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2025, five bids were received as follows for the construction of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) Group 3 Project, the rehabilitation of a recreation center athletic field at Thurgood Marshall Park located at 5150 Mark Trail Way; and

SECTION 1. That the President of the Park and Recreation Board and the City Manager are hereby authorized to execute a construction services contract with Northstar Construction, LLC, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the construction of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department Group 3 Project, the rehabilitation of a recreation center athletic field at Thurgood Marshall Park located at 5150 Mark Trail Way, in an amount not to exceed \$2,266,777.00, this being the lowest responsible bid received as indicated by the tabulation of bids.

SECTION 2. That expenditures made pursuant to this Resolution shall be made from lawfully available funds, including the General Obligation Commercial Paper Notes Series A and B (the "Commercial Paper Notes"), as amended, and any expenditures made pursuant to this Resolution from lawfully available funds shall be reimbursed from the proceeds of the Commercial Paper Notes or from the proceeds of general obligation bonds issued by the City up to the amount of expenditures authorized by this Resolution.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,266,777.00 to Northstar Construction, LLC, as follows:
