WHEREAS, V.T.C.A. Government Code Chapter 791, the Interlocal Cooperation Act (“Act”), provides authorization for a local government to contract or agree with another local government to perform governmental functions and services under the terms of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the City and Richardson Independent School District (the “District”) are political subdivisions within the State of Texas and engage in the provision of governmental services for the benefit of their residents; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter provides the Park and Recreation Board the authority to enter into agreements with municipalities for joint administration and control and supervision of facilities jointly administered; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter requires that the City Council shall approve any contract which exceeds one year in duration; and

WHEREAS, Dobie Elementary School is located approximately 450 feet from the Cottonwood Creek Trail, a City of Dallas trail; and

WHEREAS, the southeastern most portion of the Dobie Elementary School campus property, as generally depicted on the attached **Exhibit A** (the “Park Area”) is not currently required for District’s educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, City desires to construct certain park improvements within the Park Area, as generally depicted on the attached **Exhibit B** (the “Park Plan”); and

WHEREAS, District desires to allow the City and the public to use the Park Area for park purposes; and

WHEREAS, City and District desire to execute an interlocal agreement for shared access of campus grounds and the design, construction, and maintenance of park improvements at Dobie Elementary School located at 14040 Rolling Hills Lane for a term of twenty years with two five-year renewal options.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the President of the Park and Recreation Board and City Manager are hereby authorized to execute an interlocal agreement for a term of twenty years, with two five-year renewal options between the City of Dallas and the Richardson Independent School District, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for shared access of campus grounds and the design, construction, and maintenance of park improvements at Dobie Elementary School located at 14040 Rolling Hills Lane, in an amount not to exceed \$285,200.00.

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SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$285,200.00 from General Fund (subject to annual appropriations), Fund 0001, Department PKR, Unit 5010, Object 3210, Encumbrance/Contract No. PKR-2024-00026153, Vendor 333355.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
