WHEREAS, on September 21, 2016, the City Council approved an ordinance amending Article XXWII, "Storm, Water Drainage Utility," of Chapter 2, "Administration"; amending Sections 15D-5, 15D-9, 15D-9.2, 15D-9-10, 15D-9.i6, 15D-9.31, 15D-21, 15D-23, 15D-30, 15D-36, and 15D-58 of Chapter 15D, by Resolution No. 16-1529; Ordinance No. 30215; and

WHEREAS, on December 9, 2020, the City Council authorized service price agreement with Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc. dba Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc., in an estimated amount of \$1,197,000, by Resolution 20-1913.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service agreement with Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc. (VS0000075029), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for Stormwater Information Management System (SIMS) upgrade, maintenance, billing transition, and support services for the Dallas Water Utilities Department for a term of five years, in an estimated amount of \$2,590,510.00. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc. dba Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc. under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,590,510.00 to Raftelis Financial Consultants, Inc. from the Stormwater Drainage Management Fund, Fund 0061, Department SDM, Unit 4908, Object 3070, Program 717027, Encumbrance/Contract No. DWU-2025-00025717, Vendor VS0000075029.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
