**WHEREAS,** the Department of Sanitation Services ("Sanitation") provides weekly municipal solid waste and recycle collection services to approximately 250,000 residential and commercial customers in Dallas; and

**WHEREAS**, Sanitation operates approximately 156 routes with an approximate total of 100,000 stops each weekday to provide this service; and

**WHEREAS,** on May 23, 2023, a ninety-day pilot with Rubicon Global, LLC dba Rubicon for a mobile app-based route management and navigation software was authorized by Administrative Action No. 23-5709, to study the potential benefits of digitizing collection route management, which is currently managed via paper maps provided to truck drivers; and

**WHEREAS,** Sanitation has determined that the Rubicon service will enhance the overall efficiency, productivity, and safety of its municipal solid waste and recycle collection operations.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a three-year cooperative agreement with Rubicon Global, LLC dba Rubicon (VC26698), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the purchase of digital route management and navigation services for the Department of Sanitation Services for the period February 1, 2024, through January 31, 2026, estimated amount of \$839,812.50.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of \$839,812.50 (subject to annual appropriations) to Rubicon Global, LLC dba Rubicon from Contract No. SAN-2023-00023401.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
