**WHEREAS**, Dallas County, by and through the Dallas County Sheriff's Office, maintains a highway traffic program for limited-access facilities in portions of Dallas County that assists the City of Dallas in maintaining traffic management services on various highways; and

**WHEREAS**, the primary objectives of the Dallas County Highway Traffic Program are increased safety for motorists using the freeway systems in Dallas County, congestion mitigation, and improvements in air quality through enhanced traffic management; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dallas and Dallas County previously entered into funding agreements for the Dallas County Highway Traffic Program for fiscal years 2012 through 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, given the continued success of the funding strategy, the City of Dallas and Dallas County now desire to enter into an Interlocal Agreement for the funding of the Dallas County Highway Traffic Program for fiscal years 2026 through 2028, for the period October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2028; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code authorizes local governments to enter into interlocal agreements for governmental functions and services.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the Dallas County Sheriff's Office, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for reimbursement of program expenses associated with the Dallas County Highway Traffic Program for the period October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2028, in an amount not to exceed \$4,374,000.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$4,374,000.00 (subject to annual appropriations) to the Dallas County Sheriff's Office from the General Fund, Fund 0001, Department DPD, Unit 2121, Object 3070, Encumbrance/Contract No. MASC-DPD-2025-00028736, Vendor 014003.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly resolved.
