**WHEREAS**, on March 23, 2016, City Council authorized a three-year service contract for installation, monitoring and maintenance of alarm systems and annual fire alarm inspections with Communicon, LTD dba Communication Concepts in the amount of \$3,186,905 and International Systems of America, LLC dba ISA Fire & Security in the amount of \$245,464, in a total amount not to exceed \$3,432,369, by Resolution No. 16-0416.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with Protegis, LLC dba ISA Fire & Security (VS87469) through an Interlocal Agreement with Dallas County, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for citywide fire alarm inspection services for a term of three years, in the estimated amount of \$250,000. The amount payable pursuant to this cooperative purchasing agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this cooperative purchasing agreement during its term. Payments made to Protegis, LLC dba ISA Fire & Security shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Protegis, LLC dba ISA Fire & Security under the cooperative purchasing agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$250,000, but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this cooperative purchasing agreement during its term to Protegis, LLC dba ISA Fire & Security from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract No. POM-2020-00014683.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
