**WHEREAS**, Dallas Water Utilities is seeking loans from the Texas Water Development Board for low-cost financial assistance through the Flood Infrastructure Fund for two (2) eligible projects included in the Dallas Water Utilities Capital Improvements Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Water Development Board requires Council approval to submit financial assistance applications through the Flood Infrastructure Fund.

## Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager and the Director of Dallas Water Utilities (or his/her designee) are hereby authorized to represent the City of Dallas while seeking financial assistance through the Flood Infrastructure Fund from the Texas Water Development Board.

**SECTION 2.** That the designated representatives are authorized to apply for grant and loan funding not to exceed \$16,675,712 from the Texas Water Development Board for flood risk management projects associated with infrastructure relocation related to Dallas Floodway Extension included in the Dallas Water Utilities Capital Improvements Program.

**SECTION 3.** That the following firms and individuals are hereby authorized and directed to aid and assist in the preparation and submission of such application and appear on behalf of and represent the City of Dallas before any hearing held by the Texas Water Development Board on such application, to wit:
