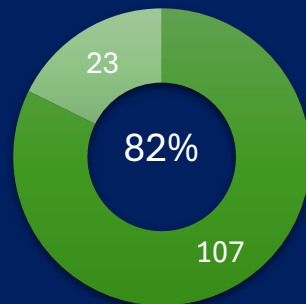

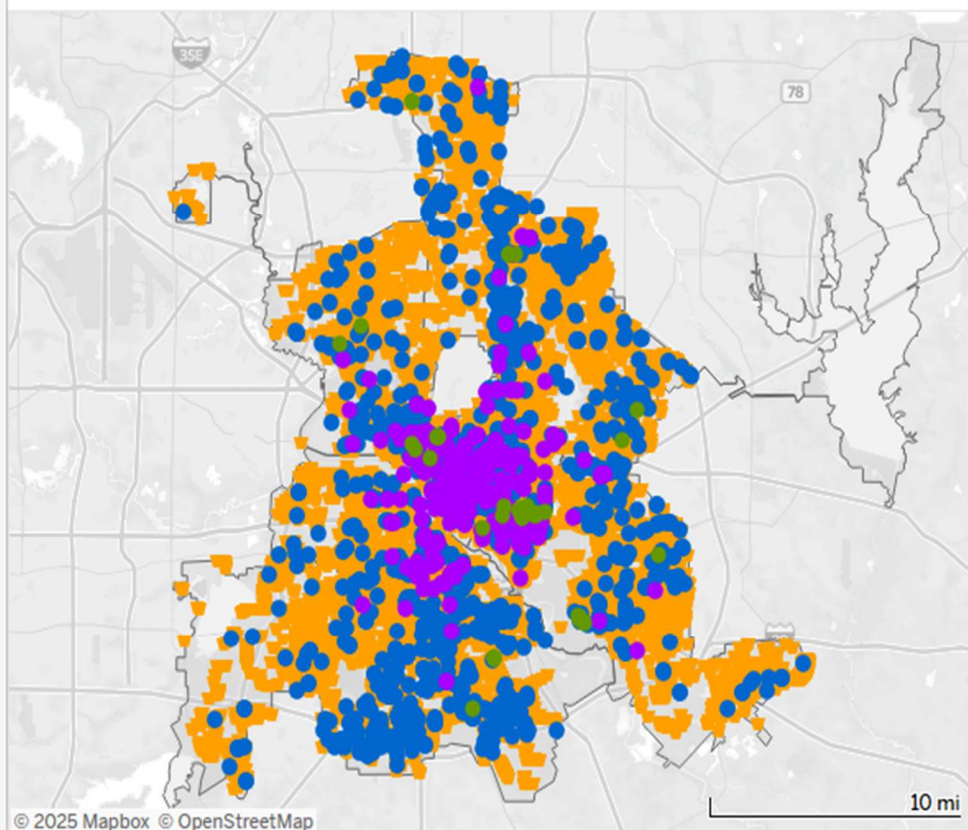

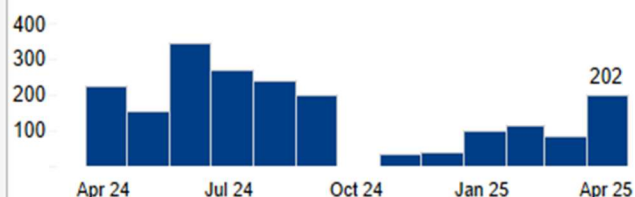

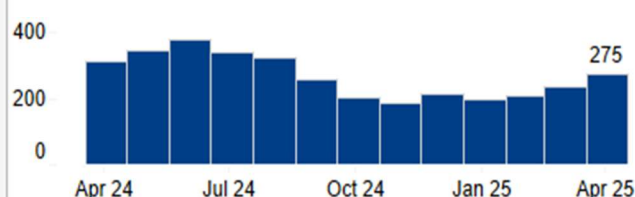

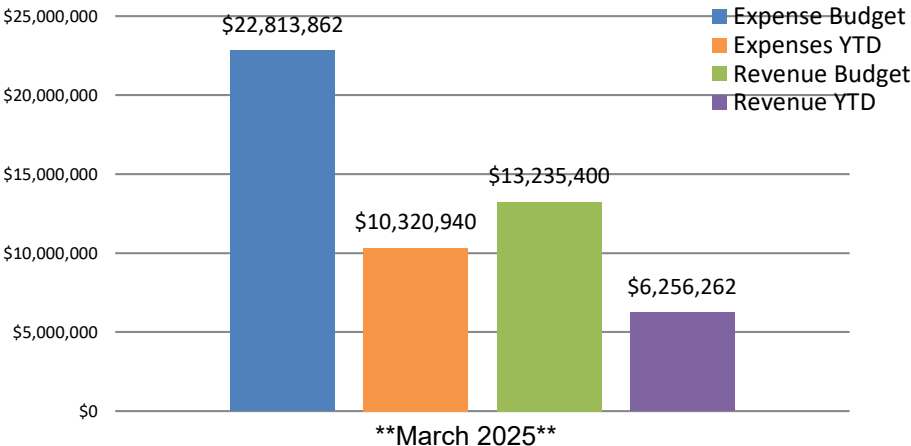

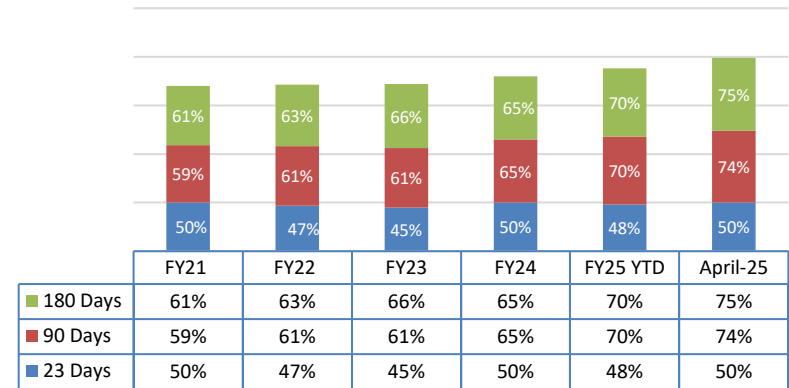


Dallas Municipal Court and Dallas Marshals Office: Month Ending April 2025

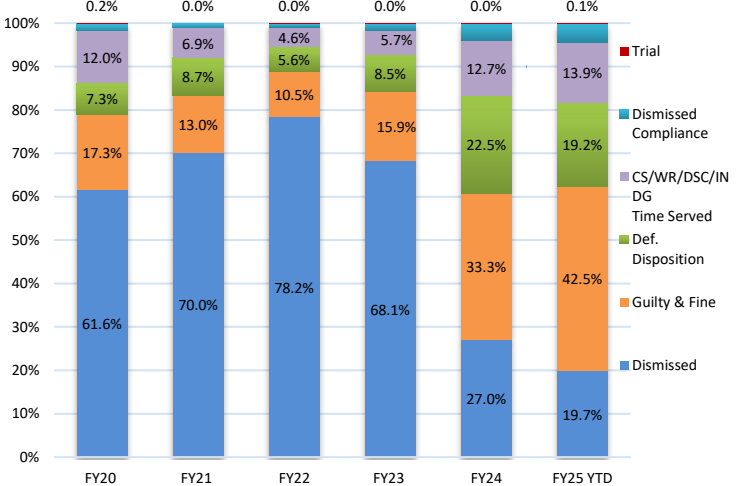
Municipal Court Budget



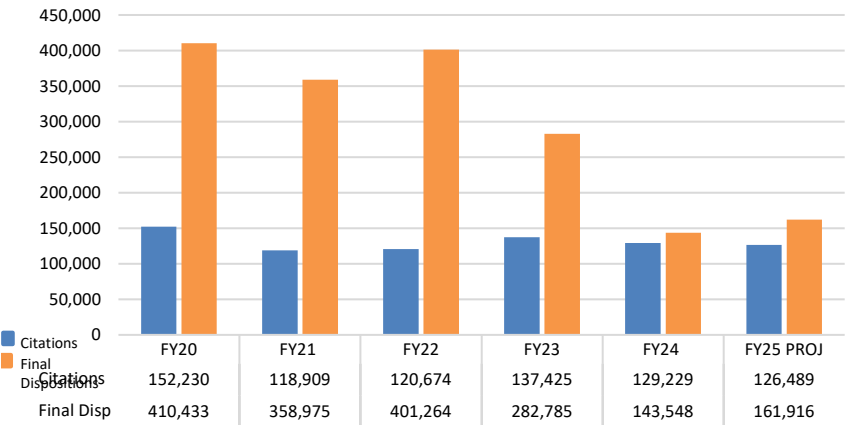
Defendant's Cumulative Response Rate
Looking Back 23, 90 & 180 Days



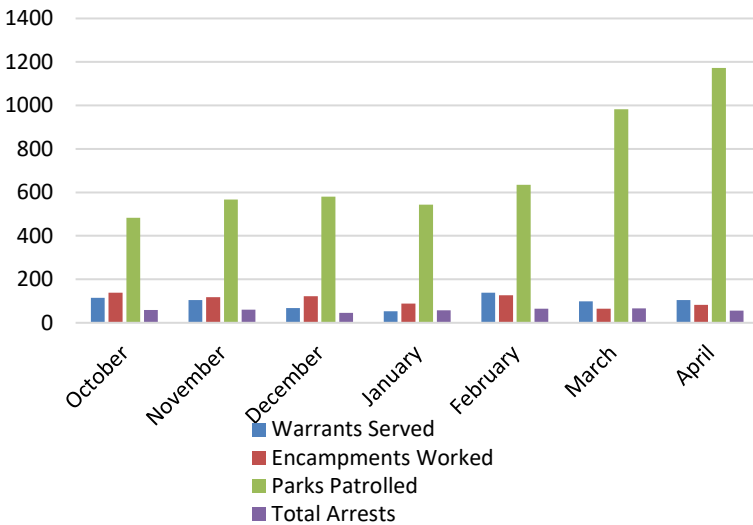
Courthouse Dispositions



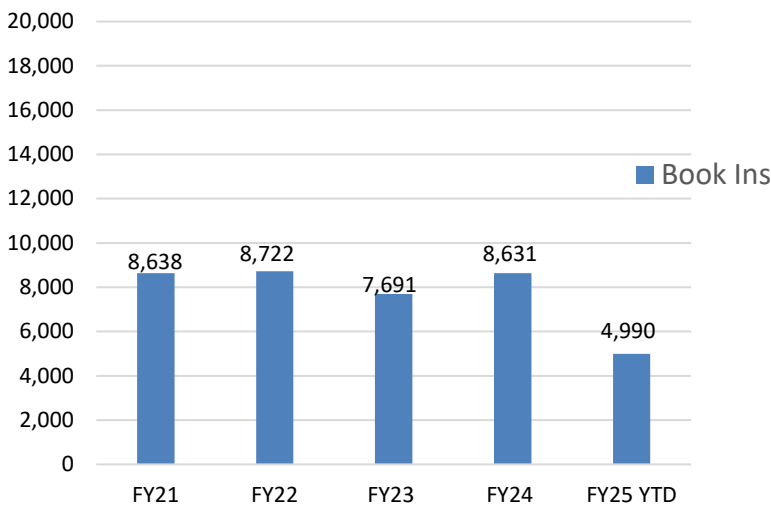
Citation Count & Final Dispositions



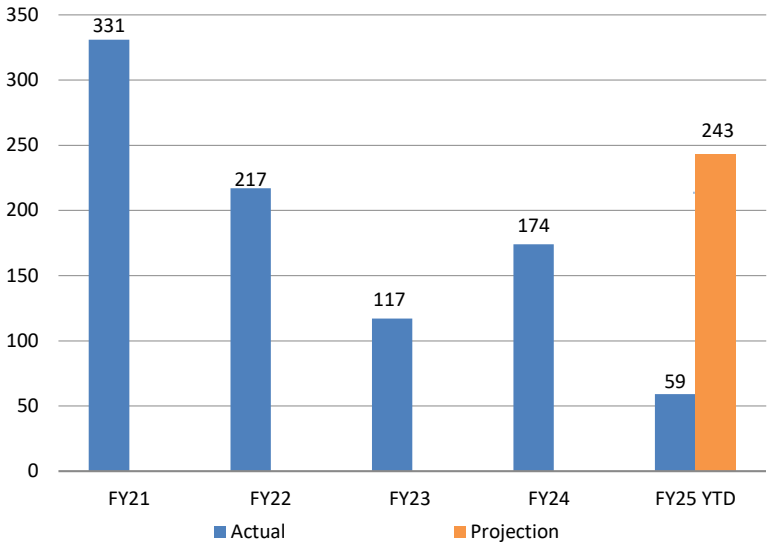

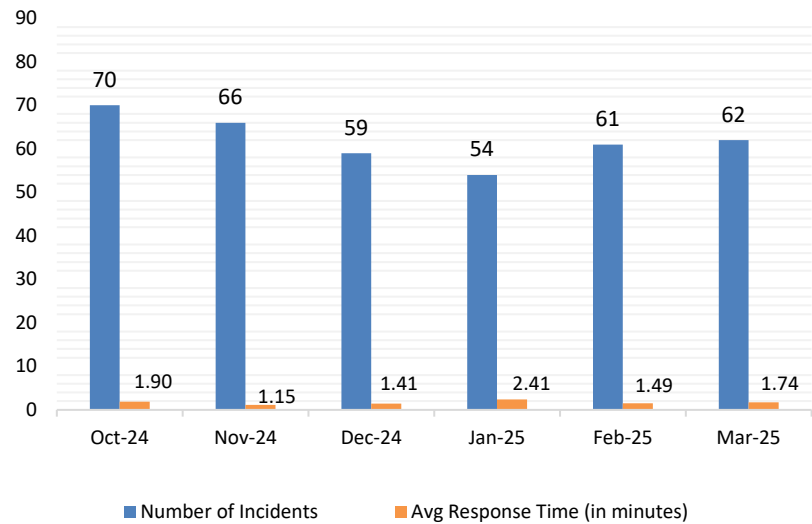
