**WHEREAS,** on June 28, 2017, City Council authorized a construction contract with Austin Filter Systems, Inc. for the construction of Erosion Control Improvements Package B, in an amount not to exceed \$6,374,483.00, by Resolution No. 17-1072; and

**WHEREAS,** on February 5, 2019, Administrative Action No. 19-0131 authorized Change Order No.1 to the construction services contract with Austin Filter Systems, Inc. for a modification to the contract for the construction of Erosion Control Improvements Package B, decreasing the contract by \$47,651.55, from \$6,374,483.00 to \$6,326,831.45; and

**WHEREAS,** on March 25, 2020, City Council authorized an increase in the construction services contract with Austin Filter Systems, Inc. for additional work associated with Erosion Control Improvements Package B for increased fill material, gabion baskets, and site restoration at various locations, increasing the contract by \$319,164.85, from \$6,326,831.45 to \$6,645,996.30, by Resolution No. 20-0490; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to authorize Change Order No. 3 for additional work at 5 locations due to unforeseen site conditions and modifications to the design; and

**WHEREAS,** Austin Filter Systems, Inc., 13653 Rutledge Spur, Austin, Texas 78717, has submitted an acceptable proposal for this additional work; and

**WHEREAS** Dallas Water Utilities recommends that the contract be increased by \$383,128.87, from \$6,645,996.30 to \$7,029,125.17.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That an increase in the construction services contract with Austin Filter Systems, Inc. (Change Order No. 3) is authorized for additional work associated with Erosion Control Improvements Package B at five locations, in an amount not to exceed \$383,128.87, increasing the contract amount from \$6,645,996.30 to \$7,029,125.17.

**SECTION 2.** That the proposed Change Order No. 3 with Austin Filter Systems, Inc., be accepted, and that the contract be revised accordingly.

**SECTION 3.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$383,128.87, as follows:
