



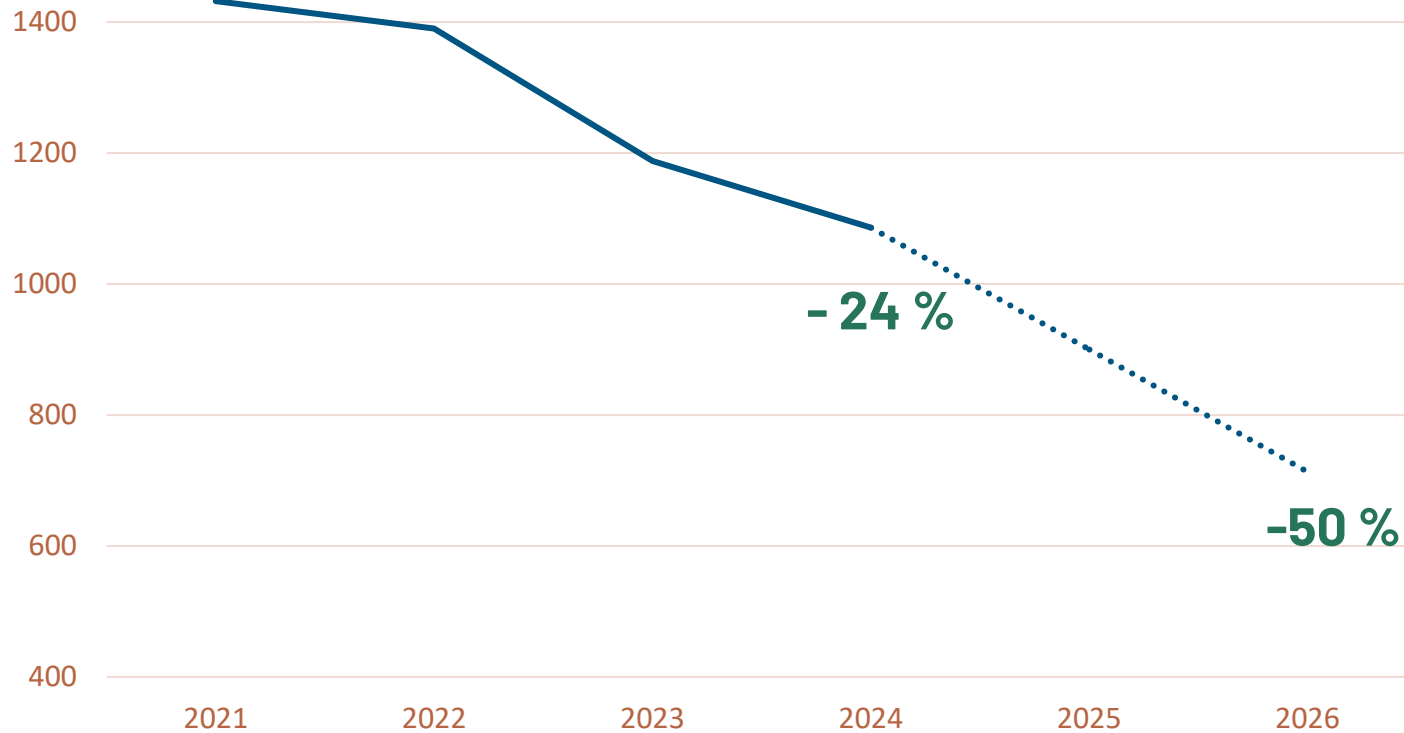

Dallas and Collin Counties Unsheltered Population, Point in Time 2021-2026

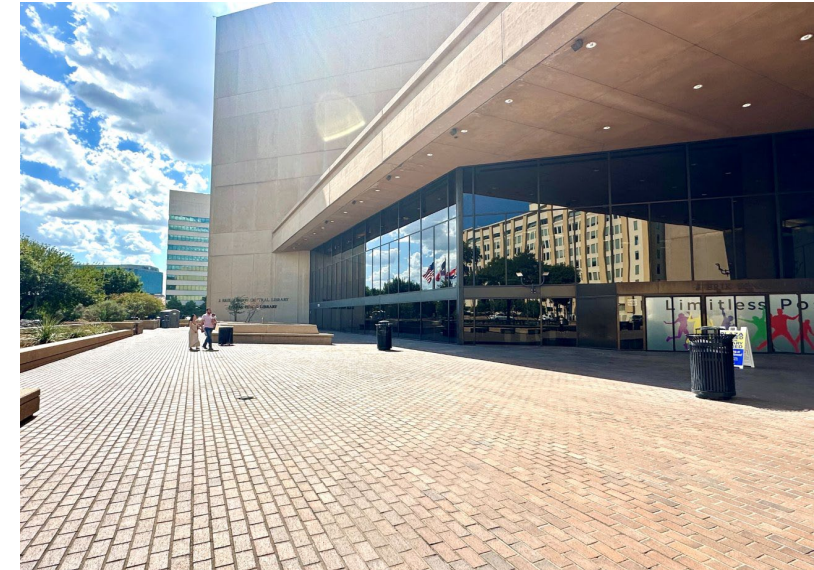


1. Continue Rehousing Pace, which led to 12,713 Housed since 2021

PATH TO 50% REDUCTION IN UNSHELTERED HOMELESSNESS

STREET-TO-HOME ENCAMPMENT RESPONSE



Address public health and safety, while ending homelessness through connections to housing and support

Target and prioritize locations across the community like downtown

Bring rehousing services and integrated behavioral healthcare to each site

Maintain site closure long-term with partners

Zone 1: The Library

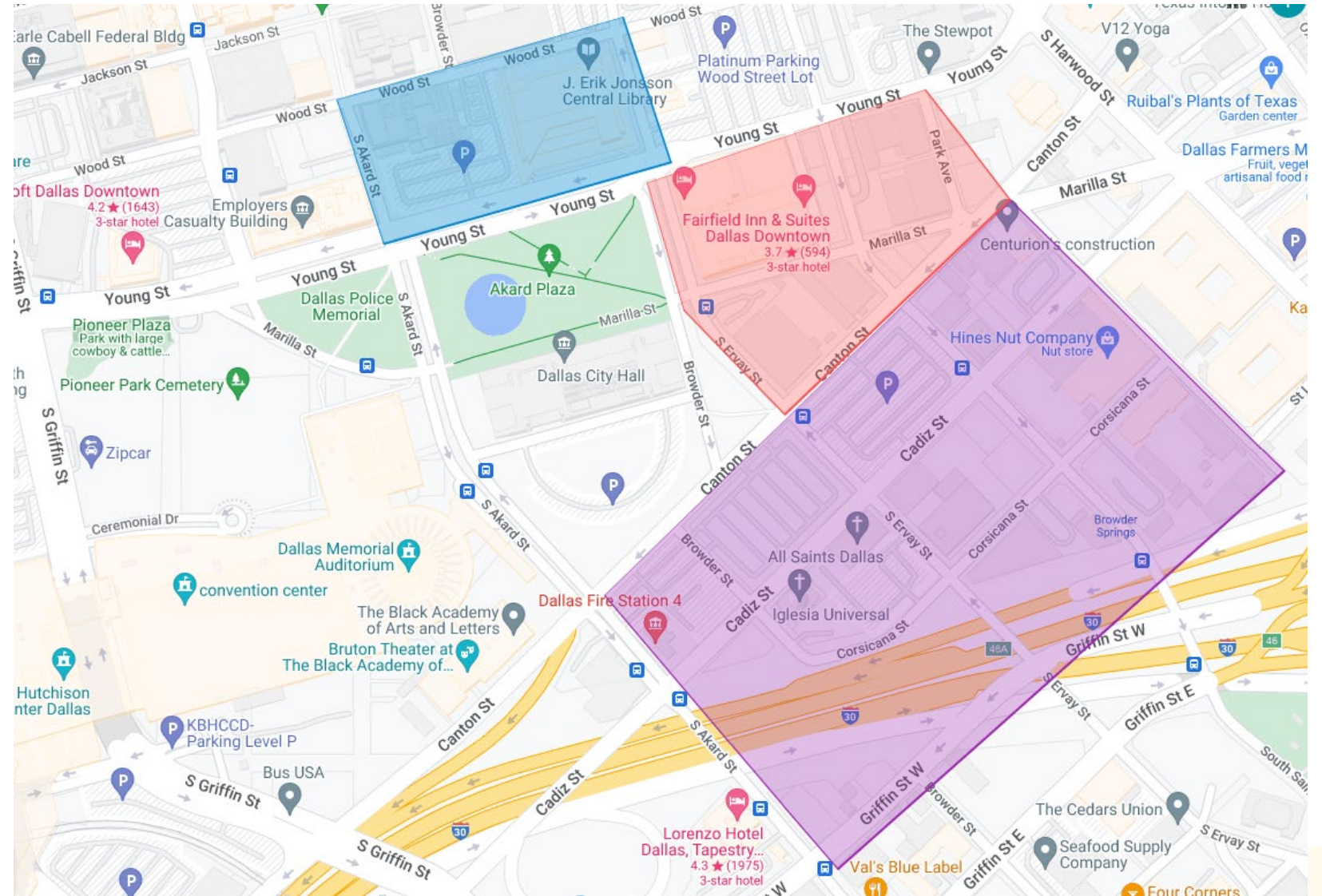

INTEGRATING BEHAVIORAL HEALTHCARE *OUTREACH AND ENGAGEMENT*

Strategies

- Behavioral Health Coordinators & Peer Specialists Join Coordinated Outreach Team to ensure care connections from first point of engagement
- Daily support during 6-week encampment closures



INTEGRATING BEHAVIORAL HEALTHCARE *HOME-BASED STABILIZATION TEAMS*

Strategies

- Two New Types of Multidisciplinary Behavioral Healthcare Teams provide comprehensive, in-home care to promote recovery and stability
- Evidence-based treatments for people with serious mental health and substance use issues

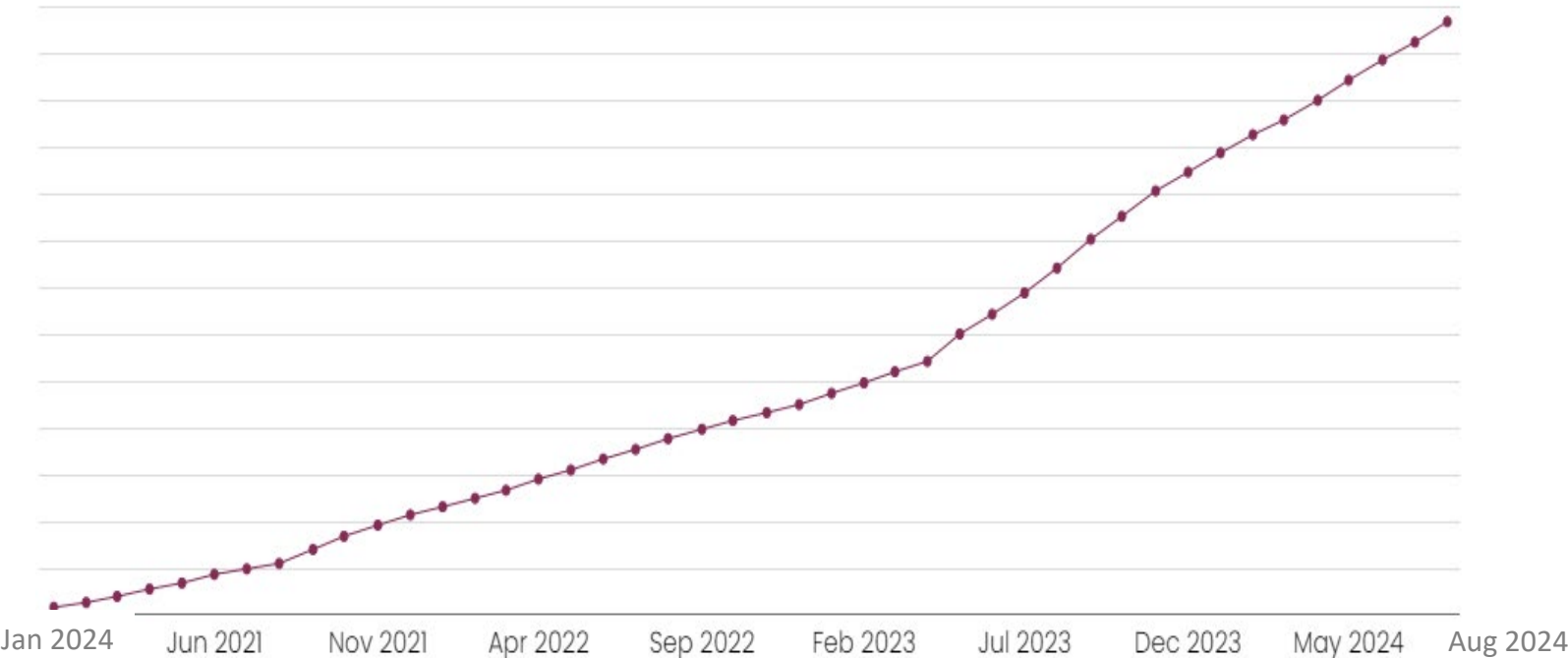
