WHEREAS, on October 8, 2019, City Council authorized a three-year service contract with (1) Prime Controls, LP for maintenance and support for the supervisory control and data acquisition systems at five water and wastewater treatment plants for the Water Utilities Department in the estimated amount of \$4,085,965; (2) HydroLynx Systems, Inc. for parts and repair of hardware for the automated local evaluation in real time system for monitoring of flood incidents for the Water Utilities Department in the estimated amount of \$510,500; (3) TriLynx Systems, LLC for the operating system software maintenance and support of the automated local evaluation in real time system for monitoring of flood incidents for the Water Utilities Department in the estimated amount of \$166,500; and (4) HSQ Technology for maintenance and support of the supervisory control and data acquisition stormwater systems for the Water Utilities Department in the estimated amount of \$517,032, by Resolution No. 19-1594.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to extend the service contract from April 7, 2023 through October 6, 2023 with **(1)** Prime Controls, LP (VS0000007557) for maintenance and support for the supervisory control and data acquisition systems at five water and wastewater treatment plants for the Water Utilities Department; **(2)** Hydrolynx Systems, Inc. (354937) for parts and repair of hardware for the automated local evaluation in real time system for monitoring of flood incidents for the Water Utilities Department; **(3)** Trilynx Systems, LLC (VS87995) for the operating system software maintenance and support of the automated local evaluation in real time system for monitoring of flood incidents for the Water Utilities Department; and **(4)** HSQ Technology (264584) for maintenance and support of the supervisory control and data acquisition stormwater systems for the Water Utilities Department, approved as to form by the City Attorney, with zero cost, having no effect on the contract amount.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
