WHEREAS, on May 27, 2020, the City Council authorized a three-year service price agreement for tree maintenance and emergency response storm services with Shawnee Mission Tree Service, Inc. dba Arbor Masters Tree Service in the estimated amount of \$26,755,161.40 and Good Earth Corporation in the estimated amount of \$707,871.00, in a total estimated amount of \$27,463,033.40, by Resolution No. 20-0838.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service price agreement with Shawnee Mission Tree Service, Inc. dba Arbor Masters (VS0000040826) approved as to form by the City Attorney, for removal and pruning of public trees, emergency activation and storm response services, and plant health care treatments for citywide use for a term of three years, in an estimated amount of \$5,508,709.50. The amount payable pursuant to this service price agreement may exceed the estimated amount, but may not exceed the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term. Payments made to Shawnee Mission Tree Service, Inc. dba Arbor Masters shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Shawnee Mission Tree Service, Inc. dba Arbor Masters under the service price agreement. The City Manager is further authorized, in the City Manager's sole discretion, to exercise an option to extend the agreement for six months by filing a notice of extension with the City Secretary's Office.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an estimated amount of at least \$5,508,709.50 (subject to annual appropriations), but not more than the amount of budgetary appropriations for this service price agreement during its term to Shawnee Mission Tree Service, Inc. dba Arbor Masters from Service Price Agreement Contract No. DWU-2023-00022395.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
