**WHEREAS**, on October 24, 2018, the City Council authorized a master agreement for the purchase of various software including perpetual, fixed term, subscription and software as a service, software maintenance, support, and implementation services with SHI Government Solutions, Mobile Wireless, LLC, and Carahsoft Technology Corporation, for five years through the Department of Information Resources, in a total estimated amount of \$6,152,763.50, by Resolution No. 18-1518; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 22, 2025, the City Council authorized a two-year master agreement for the purchase of various software including perpetual, fixed term, subscription and software as a service, software maintenance, support, implementation, and other services with Carahsoft Technology Corporation, through the Department of Information Resources, in an amount not to exceed \$15,146,691.20, by Resolution No. 25-0203.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 4 to increase the two-year master Service Price ~~a~~Agreement with Carahsoft Technology Corporation (VS0000009713), approved as to form by the city Attorney for the purchase of various software including perpetual, fixed term, subscription and software as a service, software maintenance, support, implementation, and other services, approved as to form by the City Attorney, in an amount not to exceed \$3,786,672.81, increasing the contract amount from \$15,146,691.20 to \$18,933,364.01.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$3,786,672.81 (subject to annual appropriations) to Carahsoft Technology Corporation from Master Service Price Agreement Contract No. DSV-2024-00024093.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
