**WHEREAS,** on January 24, 2018, the City Council authorized a subscription contract for the licensing, hosting, and technical support of a citywide Enterprise Asset Management System for a term of five-years with International Business Machines Corporation for Information and Technology Services, in an amount not to exceed of \$6,736,566.24, by Resolution No. 18-0206.

Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with International Business Machines Corporation (001003) through the Texas Department of Information Resources, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the ongoing licensing, hosting, and technical support for the citywide enterprise asset management system for the Department of Information and Technology Services for a term of five years, in an amount not to exceed \$11,000,353.59. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payment to International Business Machines Corporation. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by International Business Machines Corporation under the cooperative purchasing agreement.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$11,000,353.59 (subject to annual appropriations) to International Business Machines Corporation from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Contract No. DSV-2023-00022419.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
