WHEREAS, on June 22, 2005, the City Council authorized the purchase of a fire station alert system with Locution Systems, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$547,170.00, by Resolution No. 05-1997; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2009, the City Council authorized a contract amendment to extend the existing maintenance contract with Locution Systems, Inc. for continued maintenance of the automated announcement system for Dallas Fire-Rescue for a period of three-years in an amount not to exceed \$176,577.00, by Resolution No. 09-2612; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2009, the City Council authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the acquisition contract with Locution Systems, Inc. for the purchase and installation of visual alerting component reader boards in an amount not to exceed \$134,640.00, from \$547,170.00 to \$681,810.00, by Resolution No. 09-2613; and

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2012, Administrative Action No. 12-1826 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 2 for continued maintenance and support of the visual alerting readerboad system for Dallas Fire and Rescue for the period March 20, 2012 through August 31, 2012 in an amount not to exceed \$22,966.85; and

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2012, Administrative Action No. 12-2854 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 3, (via a new sole source procurement), to the maintenance and support contract for the Locution Station Alerting system and the reader board system used by Dallas Fire and Rescue for the period September 1, 2012 through August 31, 2012, in an amount not to exceed \$49,916.00; and

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2013, Administrative Action No. 13-6470 authorized continued maintenance and support of the visual alerting reader board system used by Dallas Fire & Rescue for the period September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014 in an amount not to exceed \$49,916.00; and

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2014, Administrative Action No. 14-6771 authorized continued maintenance and support of the automated audio alerting system used by Dallas Fire & Rescue for the period September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2015, in an amount not to exceed \$49,916.00; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2015, Administrative Action No. 16-5731 authorized continued maintenance and support of the automated audio alerting system used by Dallas Fire & Rescue for the period September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016, in an amount not to exceed \$49,916.00; and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2016, Administrative Action No. 16-6783 authorized continued maintenance and support of the automated audio alerting system used by Dallas Fire & Rescue, for the period September 1, 2016 through August 31, 2017, in an amount not to exceed \$49,996.00; and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2017, the City Council authorized a five-year service contract for maintenance and support of the City's automated fire station alerting system with Locution Systems, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$258,538.00, by Resolution No. 17-1525; and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2022, Administrative Action No. 22-5283 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 9 to the Maintenance and Support contract for Fire Rescue Alerting System in an amount not to exceed \$18,143.00; and

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2022, the City Council authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 10 to increase the service contract with Locution Systems, Inc. for continued maintenance and support of the existing automated fire station alerting system and to extend the term from September 28, 2022 to September 27, 2025, in an amount not to exceed \$182,906.00, from \$258,538.00 to \$441,444.00, by Resolution No. 22-1123; and

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2022, Administrative Action No. 22-6384, authorized Supplemental Agreement (SA) No. 11 to allow for upgrades at Dallas Fire - Rescue (DFR) Stations 35 and 41 in an amount not to exceed amount of \$14,308.00, from \$908,790.85 to \$923,098.85; and

WHEREAS, on December 24, 2024, Administrative Action No. 24-6613, authorized Supplemental Agreement (SA) No.12 to allow for the Prime Alert Responder Station upgrades to the fire station alerting system used by Dallas Fire and Rescue in a not to exceed amount of \$16,520.00, from \$923,098.85 to \$939,618.85.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 13 to increase the service contract with Locution Systems, Inc. (517969), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for continued maintenance and support of the automated fire station alerting system for Dallas Fire-Rescue Department, in an amount not to exceed \$238,842.52, increasing the contract amount from \$939,618.85 to \$1,178,461.37.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$238,842.52 (subject to annual appropriations) to Locution Systems, Inc. from Service Contract No. DSV-2017-00001864.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
