Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with Cyber Watch Systems, LLC (VC24277) through the Texas Department of Information Resources Cooperative agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the purchase of Rapid7 InsightVM licenses, training, and subscription services for a vulnerability management solution for the Department of Information and Technology Services for a term of three years, in an amount not to exceed \$286,907.40. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payment to Cyber Watch Systems, LLC shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Cyber Watch Systems, LLC under the cooperative purchasing agreement.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$286,907.40 (subject to annual appropriations) to Cyber Watch Systems, LLC from Cooperative Purchasing Agreement No. DSV-2025-00028449.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly resolved.
