WHEREAS, on February 12, 2025, the City Council authorized a two-year contract for software products and services, including perpetual, fixed term, subscription, software as a service, maintenance, support, implementation, and related services, with GTS Technology Solutions, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$599,492.27, by Resolution No. 25-0282; and

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a cooperative purchasing agreement with GTS Technology Solutions, Inc. (263234) through the Texas Department of Information Resources approved as to form by the City Attorney, for continuous use of a device security and management software to protect laptops, tablets, and other mobile equipment for Information and Technology Services for a term of one year, in an amount not to exceed \$404,208.00 .If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payment to GTS Technology Solutions, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by GTS Technology Solutions, Inc. under the cooperative purchasing agreement.

SECTION 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$404,208.00 to GTS Technology Solutions, Inc., as follows:
