WHEREAS, on August 24, 2022, the City Council authorized a construction services contract with Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, for the installation and rehabilitation of water and wastewater mains at 15 locations, in an amount no to exceed \$10,985,770.00, by Resolution No. 22-1230; and

WHEREAS, additional work is required for the replacement of existing wastewater pipelines not included in the original contract but that have experienced failure or where failure has been determined to be imminent without further action due to deteriorated conditions; and

WHEREAS, Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, 2005 Bluff Springs Rd., Ferris, TX 75215 has submitted an acceptable proposal for this additional work; and

WHEREAS, Dallas Water Utilities recommends that Contract No. 22-163/164 be increased by \$2,491,279.00, from \$10,985,770.00 to \$13,477,049.00.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That an increase in the construction services contract with Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC (Change Order No. 1) is authorized for additional wastewater pipeline improvements at five locations, in an amount not to exceed \$2,491,279.00, increasing the contract amount from \$10,985,770.00 to \$13,477,049.00.

SECTION 2. That the proposed Change Order No. 1 with Douglas Dailey Construction, LLC, be accepted, and that Contract No. 22-163/164 be revised accordingly.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,491,279.00, as follows:

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
