WHEREAS, funding was awarded to the City of Dallas under the U.S. Department of Justice through the Texas Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division (CJD) for the FY26 State Crisis Intervention Program Grant, Grant No. 15PBJA-23-GG-00035-BSCI, Assistance Listing No. 16.738 for the fiscal year 2026-2027; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Dallas to accept such funding.

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) through the Texas Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division (CJD) for the FY 2026 Byrne State Crisis Intervention Program (Grant No. 5414401, Federal/State Award ID. No. 15PBJA-23-GG-00035-BSCI, Assistance Listing No. 16.738) in the amount of \$234,459.45 for the purpose of funding two outreach and advocacy specialist positions to support the Dallas Police Department Community Engagement Unit and RIGHT Care Team in investigation efforts for the period October 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026; and execute the grant agreement with the CJD and all terms, conditions, and documents required by the agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to establish appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$234,459.45 in the CJD FY26 Byrne State Crisis Intervention Grant Fund, Fund F810, Department DPD, Unit 684Q, various Object Codes, in accordance with the attached Schedule A.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to receive and deposit funds in an amount not to exceed \$234,459.45 in the CJD FY26 Byrne State Crisis Intervention Grant Fund, Fund F810, Department DPD, Unit 684Q, Revenue Code 6506.

SECTION 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$234,459.45 from the CJD FY26 Byrne State Crisis Intervention Grant Fund, Fund F810, Department DPD, Unit 684Q, various Object Codes, in accordance with the attached Schedule A.

SECTION 5. That in the event of loss or misuse of funds, the grantee will return grant funds to the DOJ in full. The City Manager shall notify the appropriate City Council Committee of expenditures identified as ineligible not later than 30 days after the reimbursement.

SECTION 6. That the City Manager shall keep the appropriate City Council Committee informed of all the DOJ final monitoring reports not later than 30 days after the receipt of the report.

SECTION 7. That this contract is designated as Contract No. DPD-2026-00029233.

SECTION 8. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
