**WHEREAS**, on April 12, 2017, City Council authorized a three-year service contract with two one-year renewal options for communicable disease exposure testing for Fire-Rescue personnel with Clinical Pathology Laboratories, Inc. by Resolution No. 17-0569; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 31, 2020, Administrative Action No. 20-5800 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to exercise renewal options to the service contract Clinical Pathology Laboratories, Inc. for communicable disease exposure testing for Fire-Rescue personnel, in an amount not to exceed \$175,650; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 29, 2020, Administrative Action No. 20-6120 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 2, the first of two one-year renewal options to the service contract Clinical Pathology Laboratories, Inc. for communicable disease exposure testing for Fire-Rescue personnel, in an amount not to exceed \$175,650; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 3, 2021, Administrative Action No. 21-5615 authorized Supplemental Agreement No. 3, the second of two one-year renewal options to the service contract Clinical Pathology Laboratories, Inc. for communicable disease exposure testing for Fire-Rescue personnel, in an amount not to exceed \$175,650.

**Now, Therefore,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a service contract with Clinical Pathology Laboratories, Inc. (355858), approved as to form by the City Attorney, for communicable disease exposure laboratory testing for the Fire-Rescue Department for a term of three years, in an amount not to exceed \$186,450. If the service was bid or proposed on an as needed basis, unit price basis for performance of specified tasks, payments made to Clinical Pathology Laboratories, Inc. shall be based only on the amount of the services directed to be performed by the City and properly performed by Clinical Pathology Laboratories, Inc. under the contract.

**SECTION 2.** That the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to disburse funds in an amount not to exceed \$186,450 (subject to annual appropriations) to Clinical Pathology Laboratories, Inc. from Service Contract No. DFD-2022-00018325.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
